LONDON TRIP 25TH JUNE: There were seventeen members and friends who caught the coach at 9am for London Piccadilly. There were plenty of exhibitions to choose from including the Royal Academy,

National Gallery and the National Portrait Gallery. An added bonus for some was viewing the guests arrive in horse drawn carriages for the Queen's Garden Party at Buckingham Palace, and then following the guards playing and marching up the Mall! Although the weather was overcast it was warm and after a few hours viewing a mixture of art works, and walking some distance, everybody seemed ready to be picked up outside the Ritz by the coach for the journey back. A most enjoyable trip.

Meeting 19th June. We welcomed Joel Waring, a teacher from Surrey who demonstrated a street scene in acrylics. Working from a photograph and using wet acrylics like watercolour he created washes and shapes. Working expressively – not detailed, at the end of the first stage it looked like an abstract painting! He only uses six colours and white in his palette and focussing on working 'alla prima' with solid direct strokes, he created high contrast and life in his picture. He is holding a workshop in September which promises to be well attended.
